DR. MELISSA WALKER PROFESSOR EMERITA OF HISTORY AT CONVERSE COLLEGE

Dr. Melissa Walker is the George Dean Johnson, Jr., professor emerita of history at Converse College.

An award-winning teacher, she was named South Carolina Professor of the Year by the Carnegie Foundation for Teaching and the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education in 2007. In addition to the many classroom courses she taught, her teaching experience at Converse University also included an interim class that took students to battlefield sites throughout South Carolina to learn about the American Revolution in the southern backcountry. Additionally, in the summers of 2007 and 2009, she led workshops that were funded by the National Endowment for the Humanities Landmarks in American History and Culture workshop program for nearly two-hundred primary and secondary school educators from across the country who came to Converse University to study the American Revolution in the southern backcountry. She is the author or editor of eleven books including *The Battles of Kings Mountain and Cowpens: The American Revolution in the Southern Backcountry*.


